Stogursey Pre-School is part of Stogursey C of E Primary School and serves Stogursey and the surrounding villages. Our Pre-School is set up with quality resources, carefully matched to a young child's needs and developmental stages. It is known as the Little Acorns and as we are all aware from little acorns, great oaks grow.



This is the fundamental belief we have of how children develop, if we get the Foundations (roots) right everything else will follow. With this in mind we try to develop our curriculum around play based learning. We encourage the children to be independent learners and offer an environment to facilitate this.

For example, whilst the children enjoy making snowmen with the play dough they are also developing their fine motor control which in turn will help them to write. The staff will also be encouraging counting, colour recognition, size, shape, etc. whilst all the time chatting with the children and developing their vocabulary.

The children have also been attending Forest School once a week with our Forest School Leader, Bonnie. As the children enjoy the outside they are developing in all areas of the curriculum. The outdoors is a wonderful environment for the children to learn. They enjoy a hot chocolate and biscuit as they look inside the box to find out what they will be exploring today.

The children are at one with nature and look closely at how things change. This week we discovered the

rotten apples under the trees and spoke about the animals and bugs that might be eating them, afterwards we made Christmas decorations using string, pinecones and cinnamon sticks. Because it is winter we also made bird feeders and put them just outside our classroom window so we could see the birds come and visit us. To finish off we enjoyed jumping in muddy puddles and rolling down the hills.
